**FORWARD AIR
OCCASIONAL SHIPPER CERTIFICATION**

Welcome to Forward Air. We provide an integrated and uniform transportation system designed to move large volumes of less than truckload shipments by truck between airport locations between the United States and Canada.

Our service was designed for high volume commercial accounts but is available on a cash or credit card basis for occasional shippers who understand the nature of our service, its limitations and service terms and conditions.

Our service terms and conditions are set forth on our shipping documents and in our rules circular. A copy of our rules circular is available upon request. In tendering shipments to Forward Air, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions and should read and understand them.

1. Limits of Liability. The maximum liability of Forward Air and its subcontracting carriers for loss, damage or delay of your shipment will be \$.50 per pound per article. Our standard pricing is predicated on this released evaluation. This means that you assume the risk of loss to the extent the items you ship are worth more than this amount. You may wish to obtain cargo insurance for your protection but in any event, neither you nor your insurance company will have any right of recovery against Forward Air or its subcontractors for more than this amount.

2. Packaging. You are responsible for packaging your shipment in a manner to withstanding the ordinary perils of transportation. You should clearly and fully identify your shipment on the Forward Air shipping documents. You warrant to us that your shipment is not poisonous, toxic, or any type of hazardous material and you agree to indemnify and hold Forward Air harmless in the event you breach this warranty.

3. Non-Household Goods. Forward Air does not hold out to transport household goods as defined by federal transportation law. You warrant that your shipment is a commercial shipment, not intended for household use.

4. Motorcycle Shipping Requirements. Each motorcycle will be stored in a separate container and locked. Combination locks for 2 doors must be provided by shipper. The fuel must be drained and gas tank purged of fumes before shipping per Federal highway regulations. Fold in the mirrors if possible and empty saddle bags. Secure battery and cables to avoid electrical short. Shipper is responsible for providing 4 tie down straps and 2 combination locks. Recipient will pickup shipment within one day of shipment's arrival. Late pickup fees may be applied if this policy is not followed. Forward Air container not allowed to leave Forward Air premises at any time.

5. You agree that you have read the foregoing and agree to be bound by Forward Air's contract of carriage, shipping documents and rules circular.
